Boxtops For Education

City of Roseville Updates - Roseville Police & Roseville City Engineering Dept.

Police officer Wernli updated us about our local area. The biggest concern right now are cluster mailbox thefts. This has become a huge concern and it turns out it's not just in Roseville. Crooks all across Northern California, Oregon, etc. are targeting these. Best practices? Pick up mail as delivered, even if late at night, if possible. Also, drop off items to be mailed as close as possible to delivery. Good options — Amazon drop boxes, Bel Air post office on Foothills, PO Boxes at UPS store or Post office on Vernon

Other items of concern continue - keep garage doors closed, car/truck doors locked, and minimal items in the vehicles to discourage thefts.

BE AWARE of current scams including – phone call from the "sheriffs office" that you missed court date is a scam; buying car from someone in another state that requires payment in advance is a scam.





Noah Siviglia, City of Roseville Engineering, shared that the work done earlier (with more to come) on handicapped ramps at the corners around Junction and Cushendall and other corners is a federally funded project required by DOJ (Dept. of Justice) and DOT (Dept. of Transportation) for specific ADA requirements and provides more money for other repairs when they are needed.

Two of the three pedestrian bridges to cross from the Downtown Roseville Square to Royer Park should be finished this year. The bike trail will be extended from Folsom Rd to Downtown this year. That portion will go from Sierra College through to Darling.

Some resurfacing preparation is planned in our West Roseville area this year for streets to be resurfaced in 2018. Also, Woodcreek Oaks widening will continue all the way from Blue Oaks to Pleasant Grove. (See our Facebook page for maps and more details).
