# Roseville Police Updates

Thank you to Officer Chapman (photo on page 1) for attending our meeting and sharing local information. While distributing the newsletter and talking to neighbors we learned some cars near Hall park had windows broken and items stolen. We discussed this with Officer Chapman who recommended: Park in garages if at all possible; Lock doors and don't leave valuables in sight; Report any incident even if you don't think it will matter. It can impact where they assign officers.

#### Police Activity Log Digest, November 3-November 14, 2016 - Beat 6 (West Roseville)

West Park, suspicious activity: At Pleasant Grove and Westbrook Boulevard, a 27-year-old homeless man was cited on suspicion of possessing burglar's tools.

Fiddyment Farms, On Nov. 12, a stolen vehicle recovered, arrests made after police car and helicopter pursuit.

**\*What's a Honda Hunter Special?** Older sedans, especially 1990s to early 2000s Hondas, are the MOST COMMONLY STOLEN VEHICLES IN OUR AREA. Other cars in this category include older Toyota Camrys, Acuras and Saturns. Thieves like them because they're easy to steal with shaved keys or other common car thief tricks. If you own one of these older sedans, park it inside the garage if possible. If you don't have an enclosed garage, PLEASE get yourself a Club steering wheel lock or other visible auto theft deterrent. They're not expensive and are a great investment to protect your car. Thieves looking for a quick and easy car to steal will give yours a pass.
