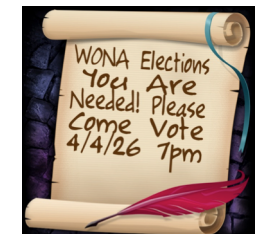

### What is a Neighborhood Association?

Have you ever wondered what we mean by a neighborhood association? It’s not the same as an HOA – Homeowners Association. Totally different! The City of Roseville CA has divided the entire city into 38 associations. The active associations, such as Woodcreek Oaks Neighborhood Association, meet regularly, elect a board annually, and work hard to improve the social, physical, and economic health in each Roseville neighborhood by sharing information, facilitating training and education, providing resources, and encouraging communication and participation among our neighbors.

We work in conjunction with RCONA (The Roseville Coalition of Neighborhood Associations) to resolve any social, physical or economic problems that may exist within our neighborhood, deal with other important neighborhood issues, and share fun and interesting activities for our neighborhood such as Movies in the Park, National Night Out, Santa in the Park, Earth Day, and more.

If you have a problem or issue in your neighborhood that is causing concern, you are welcome to come to our meetings and share that with us and with the police officers that regularly attend each meeting. Even if there are currently no issues, we welcome you to join us each month to hear what our police officers are dealing with in our neighborhood and suggestions they may share to keep us safer.

In addition, we often have guest speakers from other departments to share what’s happening in our city or our area. For example, at the 4/4/16 meeting we expect to host a speaker from the Roseville Parks and Recreation. And at our 5/2/16 meeting we are looking forward to hearing Steve Wallen of Solar City explain a great offer he wants to make to our neighborhood and to each of us.

We also look for ways to help our community in general, such as with our ongoing BoxTops drive. (See below).

Per the city’s website, it will be a “busy couple years for city building projects in Downtown Roseville.”The building above “will be home to city offices, as well as retail space on the ground floor.
