Roseville Police Department Update

Roseville Police Department sends an officer to each one of our monthly neighborhood meetings. It is an opportunity to get an update from PD on current crime trends in our neighborhood, as well as ask questions. Something brought up at a recent meeting was a reminder about the ongoing Catalytic Converters Thefts and available Etching program.

With all the end of the year vehicle sales, if you are now the proud owner of, or already owned, either a **Toyota SUV/truck, or a Dodge truck**, this info pertains especially to you.

Prevention tips, in order of effectiveness:

1. Park your vehicle inside your locked garage overnight. If you only have space for one vehicle, and you own a Toyota SUV/truck or large Dodge pickup, that vehicle should probably get priority for the garage space.
2. Talk to your auto shop about installing a skid plate or cage, or welding a thin strip of rebar over your catalytic converter assembly. The rebar welding costs around \$200. Thieves can still cut through it, but the job will be a lot noisier and take more time, so the thieves might decide to move on to a quieter, easier target.
3. Make an appointment with one of our partnering businesses to have your converter painted and etched with your vehicle's license plate number. This will make your converter harder for the thieves to resell to law-abiding scrap yards, and if a thief is caught with a collection of catalytic converters, it will help law enforcement officers identify your converter as stolen and trace it back to you. This service is free, by appointment, at the following businesses:

As always, if you notice any suspicious activity, like someone cruising the neighborhood checking out vehicles (we've known thieves to case a neighborhood during daylight hours making notes of the locations of Toyota SUVs parked in driveways, and then return at night to quickly steal them), or someone snooping underneath vehicles, call police immediately. Call non-emergency number for Roseville PD, [916-774-5000](tel:916-774-5000). Please get a good description--a picture of their car/license plate would be great--and call while they're still in the area!
