Officer Miller, patrolling beat 6, talked about recent crime trends. Catalytic converter thefts are on the rise again. Target vehicles include Toyota Sequoia and Dodge Rams. There's a city partnership with specific local businesses to provide free etching to deter theft. They have a suspect in custody in connection with the fire by Mahany.

Explained how they're short on man power, which can leave them spread a little thin during peak call volume. Urging residents to call for anything suspicious, 774-5000.

Residential burglaries frequently occur during the day, mid week, in broad daylight. Acting as a solicitor, knocking door to door. Can download a No Soliciting sign from the city website to post in a visible spot near your door.

Can use the online reporting to RPD for purposes of a simple report filing, when there's no suspect or leads.
