Crime trends in WONA – nothing significant.

Happening in Roseville to note:

Multiple mid 90's HONDA's stolen from a single neighborhood in one night. Park in the garage if possible. Don't leave valuables in the vehicle.

Scams – phone scams demanding money, in the form of Green Dot cards. Ask for their name only, look up their company, and call it yourself and ask to speak to the person. I.e. Electric company saying you're behind on payment, IRS, Grandparent scam – relative in trouble.

Panhandler laws in Roseville? Private Property not applicable. On street/intersection probably a violation. Case by case basis, since the law is specific. An officer assigned to transient calls, typically responds, if he's working.

Two nights ago, crash at Junction/Woodcreek Oaks. PD has a Facebook page – can get info from there about PD calls.

Alert Roseville - http://www.roseville.ca.us/fire/preparedness/alert_roseville.asp. New service, "Reverse 911", where you can sign up to be notified about different public service happenings around the city.

Railroad carrying crude oil concerns. Was PD notified? Residents wonder how prepared we are?

Hanging signs on electric poles, trees, a crime? Check the city clerk - they have code, but we are under non-commercial.
