**Police Updates** – Our awesome police officers popped in and shared some info about local happenings as well as graciously answering our myriads of questions! It is always very interesting to chat with them and get to know them a bit better. Check out their latest police update (as I write this) at KayeSwain.com/police-updates-April-2018 that includes this handy tip

"We recommend not leaving mail in an individual or community mail box for long periods of time. If you have valuable or confidential documents to mail, like bills or your tax return, we recommend handing it to your carrier or mailing it at the post office." And yes, sadly, they have excellent reasons for that advice!

Also, in case you were wondering about a car crash earlier in the month, the prior week's digest included, "Woodcreek Oaks & Trailee DUI: At 2:21 a.m. April 8, officers responded to a solo vehicle crash—a car had crashed into a tree on Woodcreek Oaks Blvd. at Trailee Court. Officers investigated and arrested the driver, a 23-year-old Roseville woman, on suspicion of DUI."

**City Code Info -** Have a code complaint? Submit your complaint online or call the 24 hour Code Enforcement Hotline at (916) 774-5501.

That can include such things as parking on your yard – here's some of the lates info:

**Parking within the Front and Side Yard - What's Allowed** – In 2016, the City Council adopted an amendment to the Municipal Code (Title 11 - Vehicles & Traffic) to prevent the parking of vehicles on unimproved surfaces throughout the City. This provision will make it unlawful to park on unimproved surfaces such as a front lawn or street side lawn area.

How much of my property can I improve for parking? A maximum of 50% of the required front and street side yard setback area may be improved to allow parking of vehicles, boats, recreational vehicles, campers, and trailers. You may call the City's Planning Division at (916) 774-5276 to find out what are the dimensions of your front and side setback area and how much of this area may be paved. (Improved parking areas that were installed prior to the Ordinance taking effect in 2016 were grandfathered in and are not subject to these restrictions.)

Be sure to save your Boxtops For Education! Bring them to a meeting or call us and we'll pick them up.
